Dr Brigette Ma is currently Professor and Honorary Consultant at the Department of Clinical Oncology, Chinese University of Hong Kong, and Honorary Professor, Department of Health Technology and Informatics, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. She is also the Medical Director of the Phase I Clinical Trial Centre (Oncology) and Co-Director of the Cancer Drug Testing Unit at the Department of Clinical Oncology, Prince of Wales Hospital, Chinese University of Hong Kong. Dr Ma received her Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery with Honours at Monash University, Melbourne, Australia, and was awarded Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians in 2001, Fellow of Hong Kong College of Physicians in 2004, and Doctor of Medicine in 2014 (CUHK). She underwent post-graduate training in Medical Oncology at the Peter MacCallum Cancer Institute, Melbourne, and was Research Fellow at the Princess Margaret Hospital, Toronto, Canada. She has published over 110 peer-reviewed papers and contributed to three book chapters on subjects including head and neck cancers, colorectal cancer and phase I clinical trials. She is the Vice-President of the Hong Kong Nasopharyngeal Cancer Study Group and President of the Hong Kong Head and Neck Society. Dr Ma is a member of European Society of Medical Oncology (ESMO) Consensus Working Group for the management of metastatic colorectal cancer, a member of the International Advisory Board of the Lancet Oncology, and serves in the editorial board of the Asian-Pacific Journal of Clinical Oncology. She has been a member of the Joint Scientific Committee for Phase 1 Clinical Trials, Centre of Health Protection, Hong Kong Hospital Authority, and has served on numerous advisory boards of major pharmaceutical companies. She has been a Chair/ member of the Scientific/ Organizing committees of several local and international conferences, notably, the Scientific Committee at the 2016 American Association of Cancer Research at New Orleans, USA. Dr Ma has been a member of the Women in Cancer Research Council (WICR) of the American Association of Cancer Research since 2016.
